Ask the driver for the same documents you would request from a driver of a car.

- Driver's license
- Registration
- Proof of insurance

There is no need to review shipping papers or the driver's log book.





LARGE TRUCK AND BUS TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT



If the driver does not have a CDL or has a suspended CDL, contact a MCSAP officer.

Class A

Permits the driver to operate a vehicle with a weight rating of 26,001 lbs. or more, including a towed vehicle with a weight rating of more than 10,000 lbs.

Class B

Permits the driver to operate a vehicle with a weight rating of 26,001 lbs. or more, or any such vehicle towing a vehicle with a weight rating of 10,000 lbs. or less.

Class C

Permits the driver to operate a vehicle capable of transporting 16 or more passengers, or a vehicle transporting hazardous materials that requires placarding.

COMMERICAL DRIVER'S LICENSES
